Get Hash String from PIN number

Extensive Instructions. Create a four digit (PIN) number. Push the button and enter the four digit number you just created into the response box. When you press the OK button, the hash string of the PIN number you entered appears in the text field. The PIN number goes in as the first argument of \declPINId (\declRePINId), and the hash string is the second argument of \declPINId (\declRePINId); eg,

\declPINId{5243}{02JRVZdRgYgCA-Rtje8VkD} % PIN/hash string (default) \declRePINId{1234}{By9mbLF0NJMA2sN2x4D0VB} % PIN/hash string (default)

Normally, the PIN numbers for \declPINId and \declRePINId are different.

Brief Instructions. Press Push, enter your PIN, press OK.
