I. Rational Quadratic Bezier Curves



All curves share the same Bezier points, but they differ in the weights of the points. The black curve is a parabola w = 1. Above of this all curves are hyperbolas with increasing weights, below of this are elliptic curves with decreasing weights. The line has a weight of w = 0. After this the weights are negative increasing. The curves are the complementare elliptical arcs to the positive counterparts.
