## 1 – Introduction

- The full screen backgrounds, which are the ones well suited for screen presentations, are managed by the \SeminarNewSlideFrameBackground and \SeminarSlideFrameBackground macros.<sup>a</sup>
- We can overlap several partial backgrounds with the 'fancybox' package (using it \boxput macro), calling the \slideframe[\*] macro, eventually several times (see the Seminar documentation and FAQ). See examples on slide 12 and in the file sem-dem2.pdf.
- We show here several kinds of backgrounds:
  - solid backgrounds,
  - gradient backgrounds, using the pst-grad PSTricks package,
  - **gradient** backgrounds, using the **pst-slpe** PSTricks package,
  - composite backgrounds, based on PSTricks graphics (you can obviously rather use the others (IA)T<sub>E</sub>X packages for algorithmic graphics),
  - ➡ backgrounds with external images.
